To All Our Valued Devotees,

Due to Covid-19, Sri Vadapathira Kaliamman Temple has adopted safety measures as instructed by the government, to keep our community safe during this pandemic.

The Temple has designed and implemented a system which adheres to the conditions of the advisory which was released by MCCY on 25 May 2020 and subsequently on 18 June 2020. This system is suitable for our Temple and our devotees.

It is to be noted that the Temple conducts private prayers which require prior booking. Information on this arrangement can be found at the Temple's website and at the entrance of the Temple.

The Temple allows a maximum of 30 people, in groups of five, at a time, within the temple premises. This is due to space constraints at the Temple.

Apart from the above, the Temple has also made arrangements for the walk-in devotees to view and pray to the deities, at the barricades inside the Temple.

If any devotee was denied entry, it was due to reaching our full capacity rather than for any other reasons claimed.

We would like to reiterate that our Temple has always strived to be a place of worship that is inclusive of not only our Hindu and Indian Community but of Singapore's multi-religious and diverse society.

The Temple needs to implement safe distancing during Phase 2. As such, we request the kind understanding and patience of our valued devotees if they are not allowed into the Temple due to the space constraints.
